ROUTER SETUP GUIDE

- 1. Connect a cat5 cable between one of the LAN ports of the Linksys router and the network card on the computer
- 2. In a web browser, surf to http://192.168.1.1
- 3. The default login for Linksys:
 - 1. username: admin
 - 2. password: admin
- 4. Click on Administration along the top menu bar
 - 1. Change the Router Password to "propel" without quotes
 - 2. Change Remote Administration to Enabled
 - 3. Make sure the Administration Port is 8080
 - 4. Make sure Remote Upgrade is disabled
 - 5. Make sure UPnP is disabled
- 5. Click on Save Settings
 - 1. You may now have to re-log into the Linksys with the new password
- 6. Click on Setup along the top menu bar
 - 1. Change the MTU to Enabled with a size of 1492
 - 2. Change the Local IP Address to: 172.16.1.1
 - 3. Make sure the Subnet Mask: 255.255.255.0
 - 4. Change the Local DHCP Server to Enabled and leave the default settings
- 7. Click on Save Settings
 - 1. The page won't reload after the settings have been changed due to the IP address change.
- 8. In your web browser, surf to http://172.16.1.1 and relog into the Linksys.
- 9. If you log back in successfully, the Linksys is setup correctly and can now be used in conjunction with a server to connect to the Internet.
